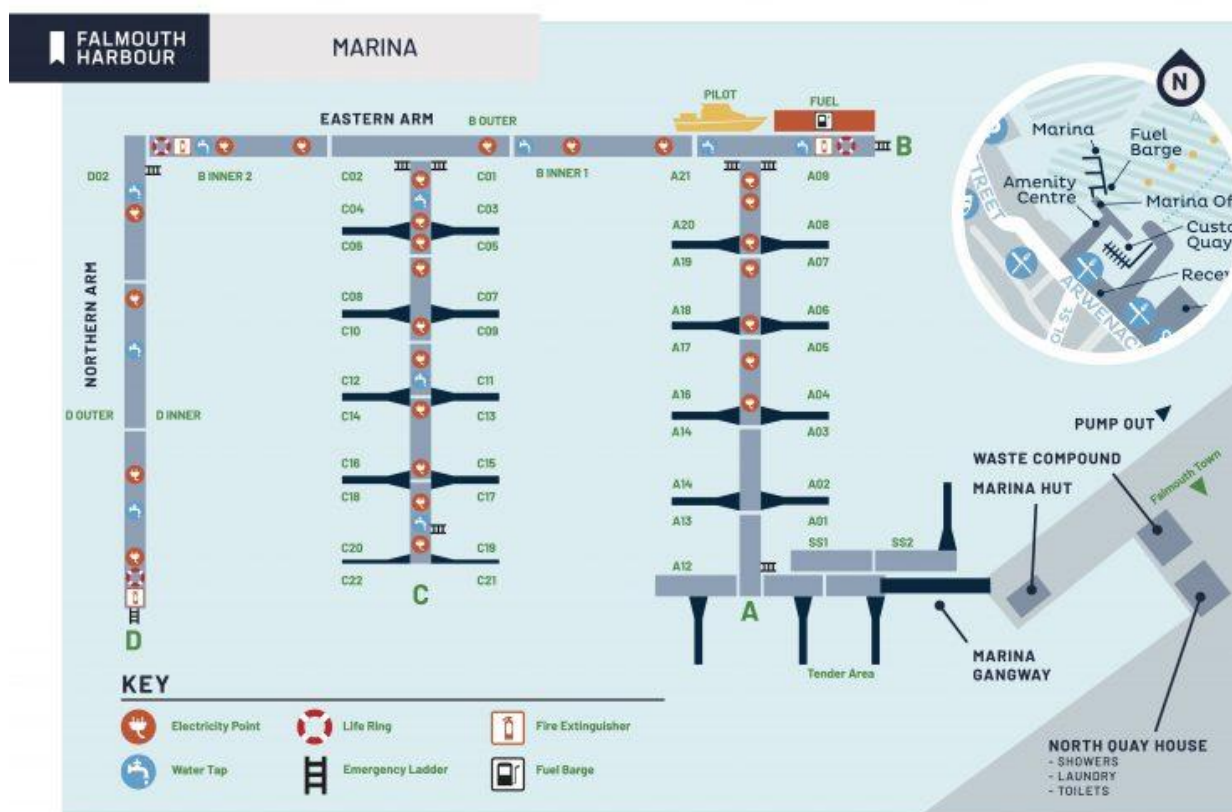


Berthing Instructions: Pre-booked Vessels with Alongside Berths

Up to 70 participating vessels <16m LOA will have reserved spaces rafted-up in [Falmouth Haven](#) on receipt of the entry form, and will have received notification by Email from the Berthing Officer, Patrick Clarke (ekralcwp@btinternet.com; **07391 352741**). Once fully booked that option will be closed on the entry system.

Vessels may occupy the allocated berthing area of the pontoons from 1100 hrs on Thursday, 11th June. On approaching Black Rock, call Falmouth Haven on VHF CH12 and declare your participation in Falmouth Classics. You will be directed towards the marina depicted here.

The Berthing Team of volunteers in conjunction with the Falmouth Haven Team will be on hand to help with rafting up according to size and type and will log each participating boat's location using this Berthing Plan for the Eastern and Northern Arms (B Outer, D Outer, D Inner, and B Inner in descending order of size). The number of rafted-up berths available totals 70 maximum, arranged as follows:

- **Eastern Arm B Outer:** 12 vessels in 3 rafts of 2 vessels nearest the Pilot berths, then 4 centre, and maximum 6 nearest the Northern end;
- **Northern Arm D Outer:** 24 vessels in 5 rafts of 4 vessels at each end of the pontoon and 6 vessels in each of the three centre rafts;
- **Northern Arm D Inner:** 26 vessels in 6 rafts of 4 vessels;
- **Eastern Arm B Inner:** 8 of the smallest vessels rafted up in the remaining space closest to the inner berths of C Pontoon.

The Berthing Team will also be on listening watch on VHF CH12 responding as Classics Pontoon.

Pre-booked Vessels with Swinging Moorings

Up to 10 participating vessels <16m LOA will have an allocated visitor's mooring in Falmouth Harbour on receipt of the entry form and will have received notification by Email from the Berthing Officer, Patrick Clarke (ekralcwp@btinternet.com; **07391 352741**). Once fully booked that option will be closed on the entry system.

Vessels may occupy their allocated mooring from 1100 hrs on Thursday, 11th June. On approaching Black Rock, call Falmouth Haven on VHF CH12 and declare your participation in Falmouth Classics. You will be directed towards the mooring allocated to you.

Pre-booked Vessels Anchoring

Participating vessels requesting anchorage in Falmouth Harbour in their entry form will receive notification from the Berthing Officer, Patrick Clarke (ekralcwp@btinternet.com; **07391 352741**). Their request will be passed to Falmouth Haven Team.

Vessels are encouraged to occupy their anchorage from 1100 hrs on Thursday, 11th June. On approaching Black Rock, call Falmouth Haven on VHF CH12 and declare your participation in Falmouth Classics. The anchorage is to the South of the yellow buoys marking the access to the fuel berth at Falmouth Haven off North Quay - see inset on the marina diagram above. Vessels anchoring must pay their daily dues to Falmouth Haven direct at the Classics discounted rate, and are subject to clearances notified by the Falmouth Haven Team in the event of scheduled shipping movements.

Pre-booked Vessels over 16m LOA - Alongside Berths

Up to four vessels over 16m and less than 20m LOA may be allocated rafted up alongside berthing subject to a donation towards the Classics as a berthing contribution (one-off donation of £67 through the entry system on the website). Berthing Officer will notify vessels so allocated these berths at Port Pendennis Marina by Email. On arrival, vessels will be coordinated by John Davison. Call VHF CH 80.

Registration

After arrival, please report to the Falmouth Classics Admin Office located in the Windjammer at Grove Place Boat Park. Sue Treneer and her team will be found in the room adjacent to the bar on the seaward side of the restaurant to take your registration and to issue your regatta bags and wristbands. The location is between Trago Mills and the Grove Place Car Park, and is equidistant between the Falmouth Haven and Port Pendennis Marinas.
