The REGATTA IN FACTS

HISTORIC PARTICIPATION: The event attracts vessels ranging from 9ft to over 150ft, including the famous Falmouth Working Boats and historic pilot cutters.

OLDEST VESSELS: Participating boats sometimes date back to the 19th century, such as the 1845-built Leigh Bawley Emma.

THE PARADE OF SAIL: The Sunday parade features traditional luggers, yachts, and the occasional tall ship.

SMALL BOAT FOCUS: A specific, popular parade highlights small classic boats, steam boats, and rowing/sculling vessels.

INTERNATIONAL APPEAL: We often attract classic boats from France, the Netherlands, Germany and even the USA.
